



Submission Guidelines

We welcome proposals that reflect the conference theme by presenting innovative research, educational initiatives, development projects, and practices that foster meaningful integration across disciplines and strengthen the connections between theory, research, and practice in teacher education.

Please note that on October 7, 2026 only Oral Presentations may be scheduled, as this day will feature dedicated online sessions.

All other presentation formats will be scheduled on October 5–6, 2026, subject to the final conference program.

General Submission Requirements

All proposals must be submitted in English through the online submission system.

Each submission should include:

- Submission category
- Title
- Author(s) and institutional affiliation(s)
- Corresponding author and email address
- 3–5 keywords
- Proposal (up to 300 words, unless otherwise specified)
- A short biography for each presenter (up to 50 words)
- To facilitate participation by our international guests and ensure a shared academic experience, all conference submissions and presentations must be in English.

Review Criteria

All proposals will undergo peer review based on the following criteria: Relevance to the conference theme, Originality and innovation, Academic and/or professional quality, Clarity and coherence, Contribution to integrative approaches in teacher education, Potential to inspire research, collaboration, and educational practice. Accepted proposals will be assigned to the most appropriate presentation format by the Scientific Committee.

Submission Categories:

1. Oral Presentation

Research, theoretical, conceptual, or empirical presentations related to the conference themes.

400 words max

Please include:

- Background
- Purpose
- Methodology or approach
- Findings (or expected outcomes)
- Conclusions and implications
- Presentation time: 15 minutes, followed by a 5-minute discussion.

2. Full session (3 to 4 presentations)

A coordinated session bringing together several presenters around a shared theme.

Please include:

- Session title
- Session overview (up to 250 words) describing the rationale, objectives, and coherence of the session
- Names and affiliations of the chair and all presenters
- Each presentation within the session must also be submitted separately as an individual proposal (up to 400 words) through the online submission system, with a clear indication that it is part of the session.

Duration: 90 minutes.

The Scientific Committee will evaluate both the overall quality and coherence of the symposium and the quality of the individual presentations.



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3. Poster Presentation

Posters may present research studies, works in progress, development projects, educational initiatives, innovative practices, or implementation models related to the conference themes.

Please include:

- Background and context
- Objectives
- Method, approach, or description of the initiative
- Main findings, outcomes, or expected contribution
- Educational and/or practical implications

Authors whose proposals are accepted for poster presentation are requested to prepare and bring a printed poster to the conference.

- Poster specifications: Size: 70 × 100 cm (portrait orientation)
- Language: English

Please use a clear layout, readable fonts, and effective visual elements to facilitate discussion with conference participants.

Presenting authors are expected to be present at their posters during the designated poster session.

Please note: Poster printing services will not be available at the conference venue. Presenters are responsible for printing and bringing their posters to the conference.

4. Workshop

Interactive sessions designed to engage participants in active learning and professional dialogue.

Please include:

- Objectives
- Session format and activities
- Expected learning outcomes

Preference will be given to workshops that actively involve participants

Duration: 60 minutes.



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5. Panel

A moderated discussion presenting multiple perspectives on a significant issue related to the conference themes.

Please include:

- Panel topic
- Central questions
- Panel members
- Format for audience engagement

Duration: 60 minutes.

6. Initiatives: Crossing Boundaries in Action

This category showcases innovative initiatives, exemplary practices, collaborative projects, and authentic cases that demonstrate multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary, or transdisciplinary approaches in action.

We welcome presentations of educational initiatives, curriculum and program development, institutional or community partnerships, implementation models, organizational innovations, and other examples that illustrate meaningful integration across disciplines in teacher education and educational settings.

Please include:

- The context and objectives
- The disciplines, sectors, or partners involved
- The integrative approach
- Outcomes, lessons learned, and implications for future research and practice

Research evidence is welcome but not required.
