

Dear All,

Starting from the **8th of September** Queen Alia Airport will proceed the Commercial Regular flights to Jordan with the following Policies & Procedures for Opening the Airport & as per the countries' classifications for COVID 19. Taking into consideration that the traveler to Jordan must be staying in the country of departure for minimum 14 Days.

These procedures and classifications will be reevaluated on the 14/09/2020.

Arrival procedure to Jordan as per the countries classification for COVID 19:

1- The Green Zone Countries

- The PCR Test should be done and available 72 hours before arriving to Jordan from the green counties classification.
- A PCR Test will be done upon arrival to the airport & inside the airport as they will be waiting in designated waiting area for the test results and upon will proceed with the procedures.
- If the results of the PCR Test is Negative & there was no interaction with a Positive result person in the plane ; they will proceed with stamping the passport and entering the county without any quarantine period

In case of positive PCR Test Result:

- The used protocol for the infected patients will be used as they will be moved to one of the designated hospitals for COVID 19 Treatment (for Non Jordanians must be paid by the patients themselves – noting that the arrivals will be asked to pay for their treatment using private insurance).
- All the people who have interacted with positive PCR Test travelers (as per the below Jordanian definition of interaction of the infected), they will be given a choice of going back on the same plane if possible or spending 1 week of quarantine at where they will be staying (home, hotel,...etc.)
- A PCR Test Will be made at day 6 of quarantine with the quarantine period to be over after spending 7 days if the test results are negative.

2- The Yellow Zone Countries

- The PCR Test should be done and available 72 hours before arriving to Jordan from the yellow counties classification.
- Quarantine for 7 Days at a designated hotel will be obligatory (must be paid by the traveler) with 2 PCR Tests. The 1st test must be made on day 1 and the 2nd on day 7 . The traveler will leave quarantine on day 8 if the test results where negative with a follow up 7 – day home quarantine.

3- The Red Zone Countries

- The PCR Test should be done and available 72 hours before arriving to Jordan from the red counties classification.
- Quarantine for 7 Days at a designated hotel will be obligatory (must be paid by the traveler) with 2 PCR Tests. The 1st test must be made on day 1 and the 2nd on day 7 . The traveler will leave quarantine on day 8 if the test results where negative with a follow up 7 – day home quarantine with a compulsory location – detecting bracelet.

Jordanian definition of interaction of the infected:

- 1- PCR Test – on arrival day – must have negative results.
- 2- The seat must be in the radius of 2 seats to the left or right from the infected traveler.
- 3- Or to be seated up to 2 Rows behind or in front of the infected traveler.

In case of a positive PCR Test Result for any traveler on the plane the whole airplane staff will be treated as people who interacted of the infected traveler, and will be treated with the same above protocol.
