Dear Colleagues and Clients,

Further to our updates dated February 6, 2020 and February 24, 2020, we would like to advise you that in accordance with a new notification of the Ministry of Health:

- Any individual returning from Italy, as of today, Thursday, February 27, 2020 (and not as initially notified), is required to be quarantined in home isolation for 14 days.
- The Ministry of Health has recommended to the public to consider the necessity of trips abroad in general, in addition to the requirement that individuals returning from specific countries be quarantined in home isolation. As a reminder - Upon returning from the following updated list of countries, individuals are required to be quarantined in home isolation, regardless of whether or not they have developed any symptoms: China, Hong-Kong, Thailand, Singapore, Macao, South Korea, Japan and Italy.
- The Ministry of Health has instructed the public to avoid participating in international conferences and gatherings, including travelling to religious events, which are attended by participants from around the world.
- The Ministry of health has instructed that the public refrain from holding international conferences in Israel.

We note that the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs remain unchanged since our previous update.
